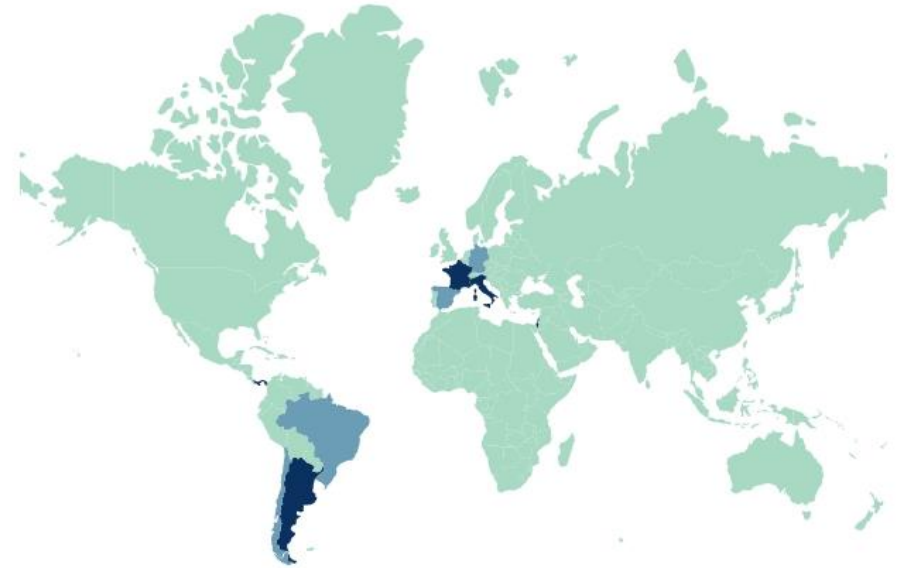
MAIN OBJECTIVES:

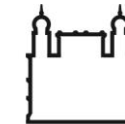
