# ICPerMed Best Practise Recognition



The Recognition calls 2018, 2019 & 2020 ,hosted by the Italian Ministry of Health (It-MoH), has been launched annually / big ICPerMed events.



*The Best Practice Recognition Call (BPR) aimed to recognise, encourage, promote and disseminate outstanding examples of Best Practices in PM and addressed people that published scientific papers and/or developed Best Practice strategies in the field of PM.*



Proposals for applicants worldwide were considered during the two last editions.



The different editions focused in examples developed between January and October (previous year)

# Evaluation Criteria

A higher score considered if it covers appropriately more than one area.



1.- Knowledge Production



2.- Research capacity-building and targeting



3.- Informing policy and practice



4.- Population health and health sector benefits



5.-Economic impacts



For each criterion, your proposal will be given scores of 1 to 5 (half marks are possible).



Total Score: 1-5  
THRESHOLD >2

# Process of selection:

- A maximum number of three proposals will be selected via a competitive public call planned by the ICPeMed Secretariat and approved by ICPeMed bodies.
- The first authors of the selected proposal (s) will be invited to present their results during a plenary session in the correlated ICPeMed big event (ICPeMed workshop or conference).
- Abstracts of these selected talk(s) during the ICPeMed event will be published in the event report; the talk(s) will be made available on the ICPeMed website.
- For improving the dissemination of their outcomes, the successful candidates will be invited to disseminate the best practice example to new settings

Eligibility, Application, Evaluation and Management will be driven with the same rules than during last calls.

Area 1: Scientific paper focused on novel approaches for the implementation of PM

Area 2: Training programmes for health personnel, increasing the level of awareness on the potential of PM

Area 3: Examples for interdisciplinary or inter-sectoral groups of collaboration (governmental and nongovernmental organisations, academic management, medical research and Health Care), for the implementation of PM, including Ethical, Legal and Social Issues (ELSI) activities

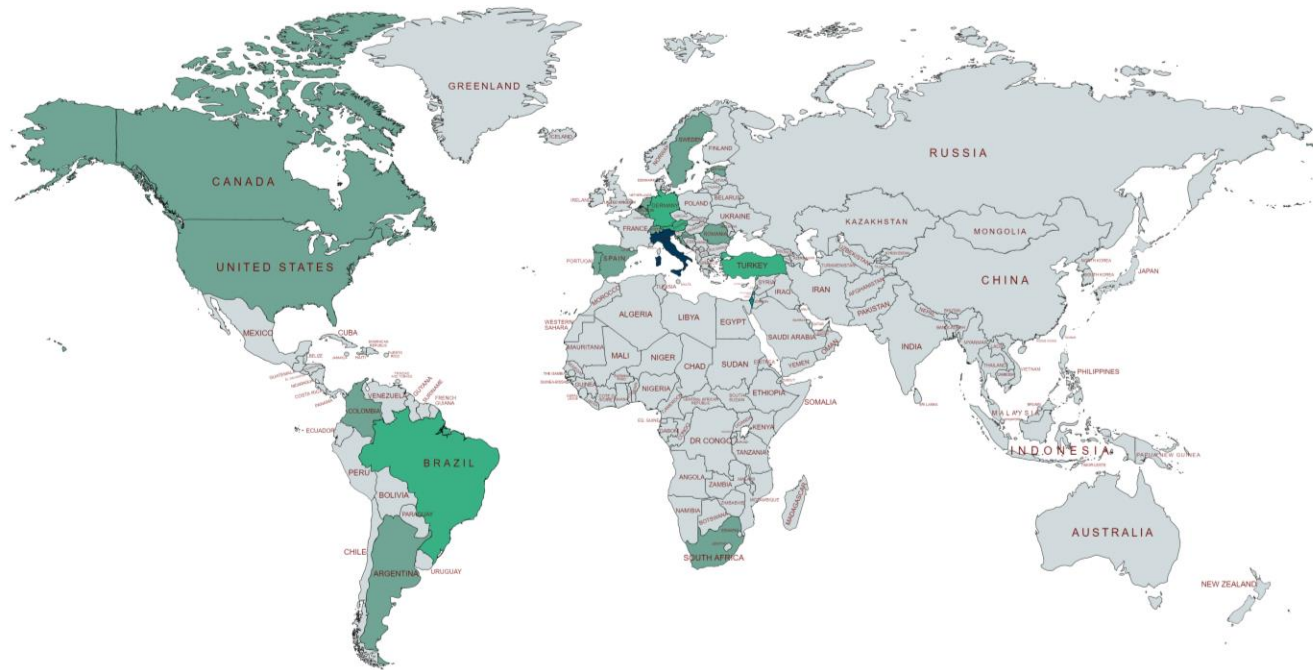

## GEOGRAPICAL DISTRIBUTION APPLICATIONS

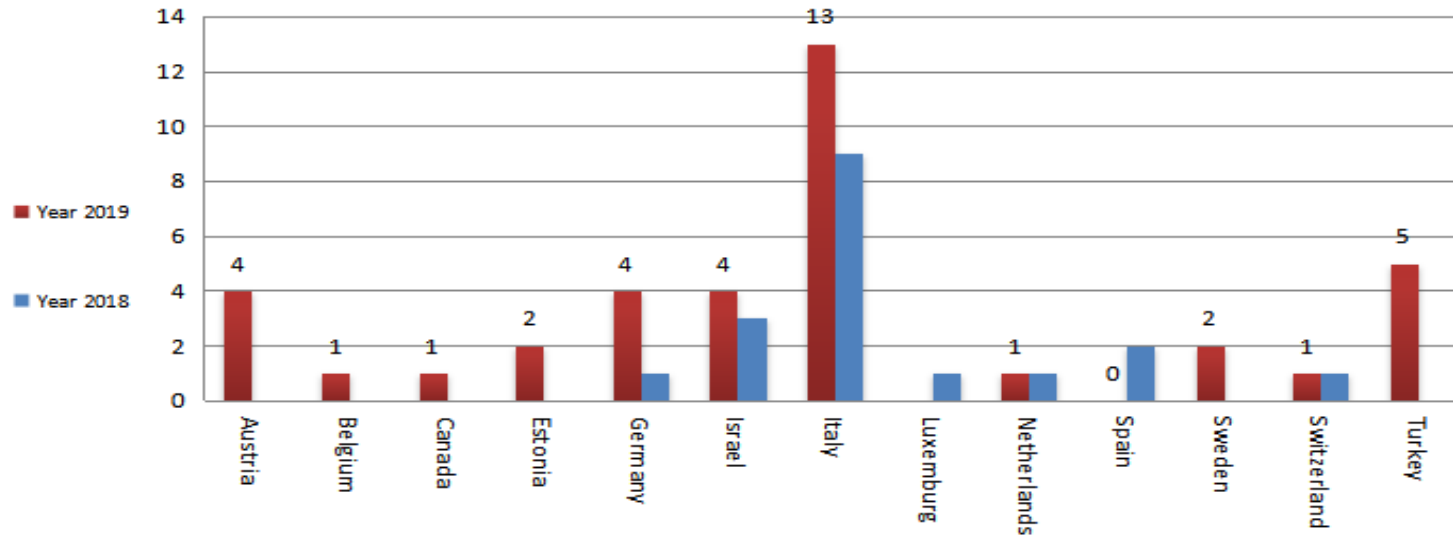

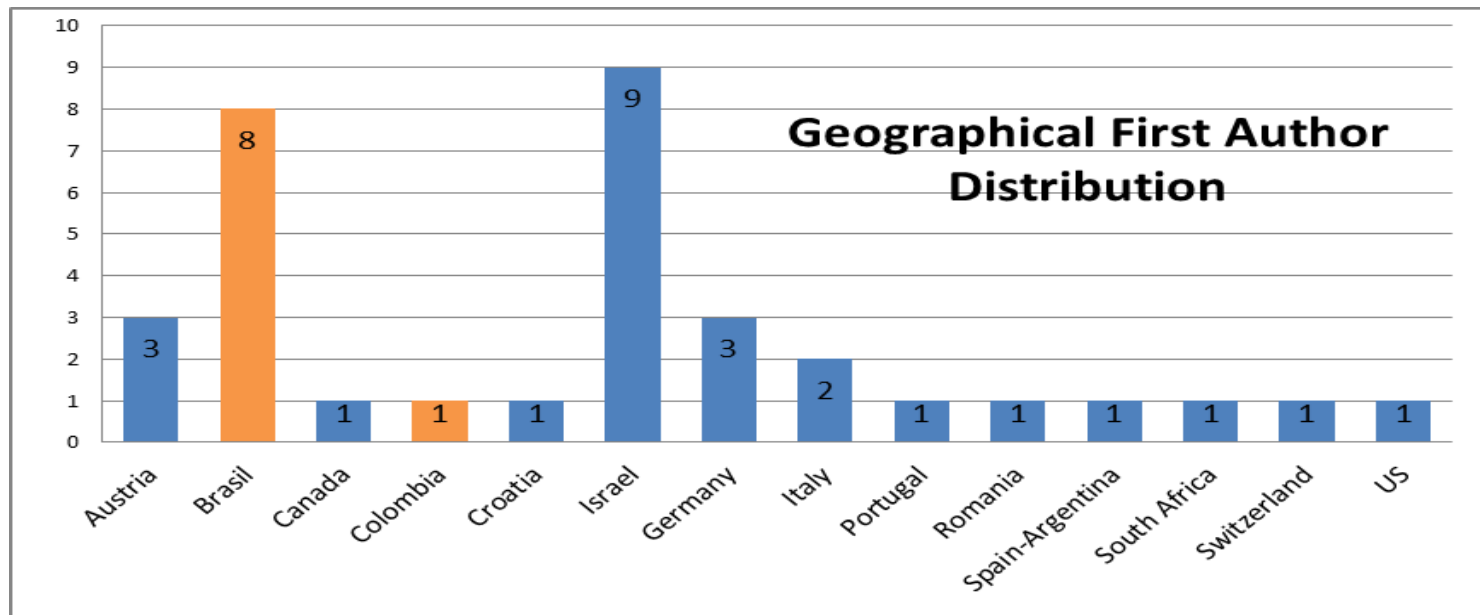

### Geographic Distribution Applications Call 2018 and 2019

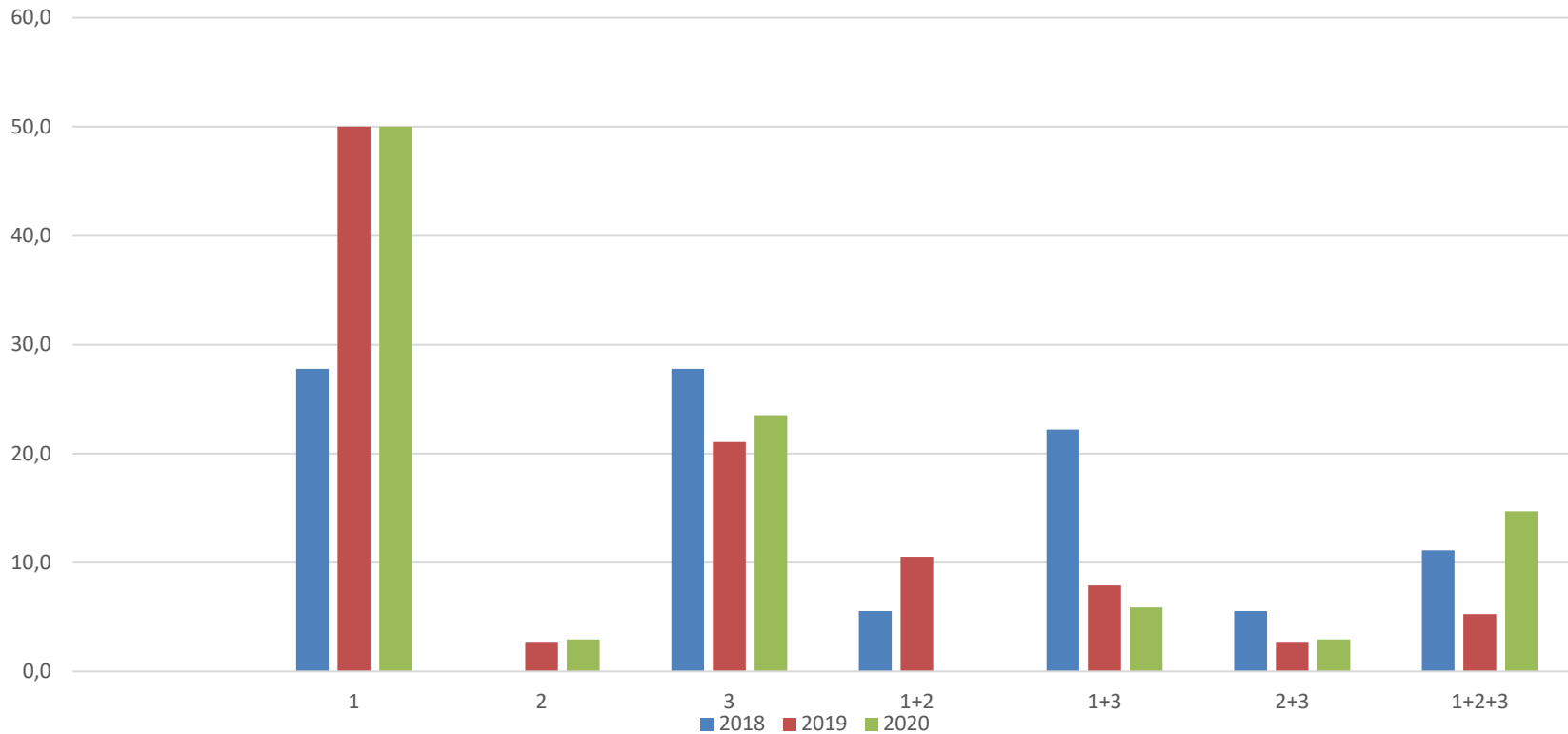


The call open worldwide received applications from Argentina, Brasil, Colombia, Croatia, Portugal, Romania , South Africa and US



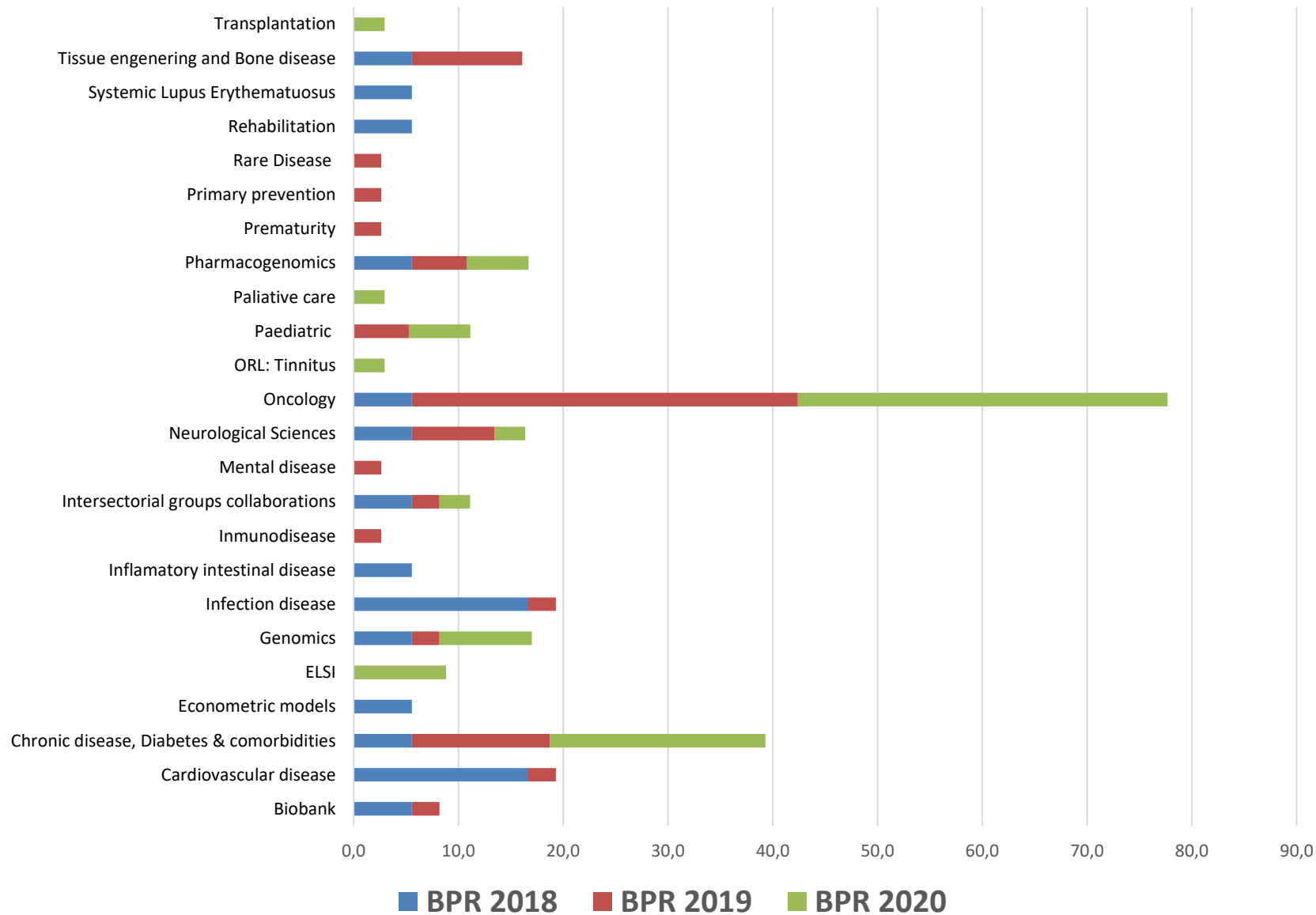


## BPR Selected Area 2018, 2019 and 2020

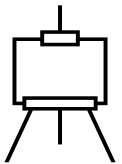
### BPR Main Sectors of Disease : Evolution
